
## Key Findings from the 2023 NCVS: Prevalence

**Prevalence** represents the number or percentage of unique persons who were crime victims, or of unique households that experienced crime

## In the United States, 1.36% of persons age 12 or older experienced at least one violent crime



## **Violent crime**

rape or sexual assault, robbery, aggravated assault, and simple assault

## **Property crime**

burglary or trespassing, motor vehicle theft, and other types of household theft
