
## **Key Findings from the 2022 NCVS**

After reaching a 30-year low during 2020–2021, an estimated 1.24% of persons age 12 or older in the U.S. experienced at least one violent crime in 2022.



## **Violent crime**

includes rape or sexual assault, robbery, aggravated assault, and simple assault.

## **Property crime**

includes burglary or trespassing, motor vehicle theft, and other types of household theft.
