



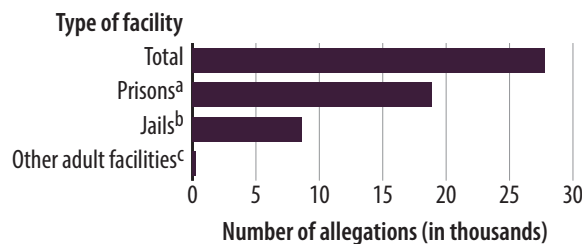
Survey of Sexual Victimization in Adult Correctional Facilities, 2012-2018 – Statistical Tables

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In 2018, correctional administrators reported 27,826 allegations of sexual victimization in adult correctional facilities across the United States (**figure 1**). Allegations included inmate-on-inmate nonconsensual sexual acts, inmate-on-inmate abusive sexual contact, staff-on-inmate sexual misconduct, and staff-on-inmate sexual harassment. About 6% (1,673) of the allegations were substantiated incidents. Federal, state, and private prison administrators reported most (68%, or 18,884) allegations of sexual victimization. Meanwhile, jails reported 31% (8,651), and other adult facilities (military prisons, dedicated U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement facilities, and jails in Indian country) reported 1% (291).

These statistical tables provide summary counts of allegations and substantiated incidents in adult correctional facilities reported in the 2012 to 2018 Survey of Sexual Victimization (SSV,

Highlights

- Prison administrators reported 18,884 allegations of sexual victimization in 2018, which was 2.5 times the 7,575 reported in 2012 (**table 1**).
- Jail administrators reported 3.5 times as many alleged sexual victimizations in 2018 (8,651) as in 2012 (2,411).
- In adult correctional facilities, more alleged sexual victimizations were substantiated in 2018 (1,673 incidents) than in 2012 (953), with prisons driving 61% of this increase (up 438) and jails 35% (up 255).
- While both allegations and substantiated incidents of sexual victimization rose in adult correctional facilities from 2012 to 2018, the share of allegations that were substantiated fell from 9% to 6%.
- A total of 28,068 allegations of inmate-on-inmate sexual harassment were made during 2016-18, up from 15,810 during 2013-15 (**tables 2 and 3**).

formerly the Survey of Sexual Violence). Detailed data by type of victimization for each state system and large jail jurisdiction is also presented. These tables accompany the Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS) reports *Sexual Victimization Reported by Adult Correctional Authorities, 2012–15* (NCJ 251146, BJS, July 2018) and *Sexual Victimization Reported by Adult Correctional Authorities, 2016–2018* (NCJ 255356, BJS, June 2021), which provide national estimates and rates

of allegations of sexual victimization and outcomes of investigations.

BJS has collected official records on allegations and substantiated incidents of inmate-on-inmate and staff-on-inmate sexual victimization through the SSV each year since 2004. The SSV is among the data collections that BJS conducts to meet the requirements of the Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003.

Other key findings

- Between the 3-year periods of 2013-15 and 2016-18, allegations of inmate-on-inmate sexual harassment increased 110% in jails (from 5,671 to 11,881) and 61% in prisons (from 10,000 to 16,060) (**tables 2 and 3**).
- During 2016-18, 10% (1,513 of 14,945) of the inmate-on-inmate sexual harassments alleged in public prisons were substantiated, down from 12% (1,129 of 9,411) during 2013-15.
- During 2016-18, 15% (1,834 of 11,881) of alleged inmate-on-inmate sexual harassments in jails were substantiated, down from 21% (1,196 of 5,671) during 2013-15.
- The number of allegations of nonconsensual sexual acts in federal and state prisons grew from 2,186 in 2012 to 3,541 in 2018 (**tables 5 and 10**).
- Large local jail administrators substantiated 10% (178 of 1,720) of inmate-on-inmate sexual harassments alleged in their facilities, compared to 28% (121 of 434) in 2013 (**tables 20 and 21**).

Terms and definitions

The Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS) uses uniform definitions for each sexual act and investigative outcome. Each sexual act is classified by the perpetrator who carried out the incident (i.e., inmate or staff) and the type of act. In 2013, BJS modified the survey to align the definitions with the national standards. BJS began collecting data on inmate-on-inmate sexual harassment in 2013.

Inmate-on-inmate sexual victimization involves nonconsensual sexual acts or abusive contact with a victim without his or her consent or with a victim who cannot consent or refuse. Attempted nonconsensual sexual acts are included if they were recorded by correctional administrators. Respondents are not asked to specify the subcategory of inmate-on-inmate sexual victimization in which these attempted acts were recorded. As a result, the specific type of act is unknown and is classified as attempted nonconsensual sexual acts or as abusive sexual contacts as determined by the correctional authorities.

Nonconsensual sexual acts are the most serious victimizations and include—

- contact between the penis and the vulva or the penis and the anus, including penetration, however slight
- contact between the mouth and the penis, vulva, or anus
- penetration of the anal or genital opening of another person, however slight, by a hand, finger, object, or other instrument.

Abusive sexual contact is less serious and includes intentional touching, either directly or through the clothing, of the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh, or buttocks of any person. Incidents in which the contact was incidental to a physical altercation are excluded.

Inmate-on-inmate sexual harassment includes repeated and unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, or verbal comments, gestures, or actions of a derogatory or offensive sexual nature by one inmate directed toward another.

Staff-on-inmate sexual victimization includes sexual misconduct or sexual harassment perpetrated on an inmate by staff. Staff includes an employee, volunteer, contractor, official visitor, or other agency representative. Family, friends, and other visitors are excluded.

Staff sexual misconduct includes any consensual or nonconsensual behavior or act of a sexual nature directed toward an inmate by staff, including romantic relationships. Such acts include—

- intentional touching, either directly or through the clothing, of the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh, or buttocks that is unrelated to official duties or with the intent to abuse, arouse, or gratify sexual desire
- completed, attempted, threatened, or requested sexual acts
- occurrences of indecent exposure, invasion of privacy, or staff voyeurism for reasons unrelated to official duties or for sexual gratification.

Staff sexual harassment includes repeated verbal comments or gestures of a sexual nature to an inmate by staff. Such statements include—

- demeaning references to an inmate's gender or sexually suggestive or derogatory comments about his or her body or clothing
- repeated profane or obscene language or gestures.

Substantiated allegation means the event was investigated and determined to have occurred, based (per 28 C.F.R. § 115.72) on a preponderance of the evidence.

Unsubstantiated allegation means the investigation concluded that evidence was insufficient to determine whether or not the event occurred.

Unfounded allegation means the investigation determined that the event did not occur.

Under investigation means that correctional administrators were still investigating an allegation at the time of data collection.

Methodology

The Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS) began the Survey of Sexual Victimization (SSV, formerly the Survey of Sexual Violence) in 2004. Mandated by the Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003 (PREA), this annual collection measures the incidence of prison rape. The survey is based on official administrative records of correctional systems and facilities and covers all federal and state prisons, all facilities operated by the U.S. military and U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), and a representative sample of local jails, jails in Indian country, and privately operated jails and prisons. The U.S. Census Bureau currently serves as the data collection agent for the SSV.

Sampling designs

The sampling designs for the 2012 through 2018 SSVs varied for each type of facility covered by PREA. For detailed descriptions of sampling designs for all types of facilities and for information on estimation, see the *Methodology in Sexual Victimization Reported by Adult Correctional Administrators, 2012–15* (NCJ 251146, BJS, July 2018) and *Sexual Victimization Reported by Adult Correctional Administrators, 2016–2018* (NCJ 255356, BJS, June 2021).

Federal and state prisons

For each year, the survey included the Federal Bureau of Prisons (BOP) and all 50 state adult prison systems.¹ Prison administrators reported on allegations and substantiated incidents of sexual victimization that occurred within publicly operated adult prison facilities only. They excluded allegations and incidents involving federal or state inmates in other facilities, such as privately operated prisons or jails.

Public jails

A sample of 700 publicly operated jail jurisdictions was drawn each year from BJS's Mortality in Correctional Institutions (MCI; formerly Deaths in Custody Reporting Program). For each SSV data collection, the preceding year of the MCI was used as the sampling frame. For example, the 2017 MCI was used for the 2018 SSV. For the 2012 SSV, BJS included 2,844 jail jurisdictions in the frame. There were 2,921 jail jurisdictions in 2013, 2,918 in 2014, 2,904 in 2015, 2,884 in 2016, 2,874 in 2017, and 2,841 in 2018.

Each year, the largest jail jurisdiction was selected with certainty in 45 states and the District of Columbia.² Jail jurisdictions with average daily populations (ADP) greater than or equal to 1,000 inmates were also selected with certainty (116 in 2012, 118 in 2013, 117 in 2014, 111 in 2015, 108 in 2016, 103 in 2017, and 106 in 2018). These are the large local jail jurisdictions included in this report. The remaining jail jurisdictions on each frame were then grouped into three strata based on ADP, sorted by region and state, and selected with probability proportional to size. A few large local jail jurisdictions were selected with certainty in some years and selected with probability proportional to size in other years. Those jurisdictions are included here for all years they were selected in the sample.

Among the large local jail jurisdictions selected in the samples, all were in operation at the time the surveys were conducted. All responded to the 2012, 2015, and 2016 surveys. Two did not respond to the 2013 survey, one did not respond to the 2014 survey, and four did not respond to both the 2017 and 2018 surveys. Nonresponding jurisdictions in each indicated year are listed below.

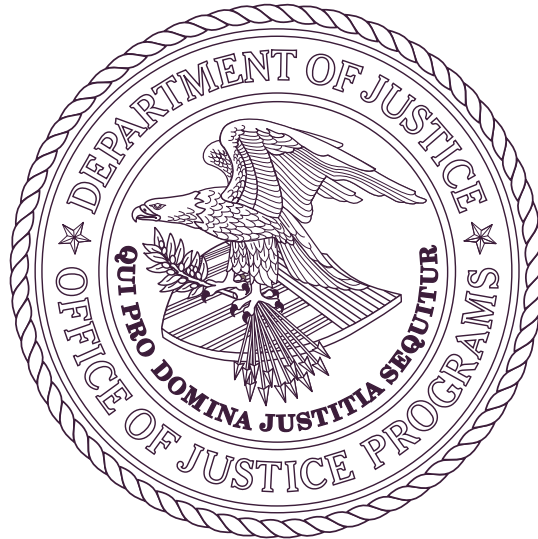
